BACKGROUND

An opportunity presented itself for Everards Brewery to relocate to land adjacent to Fosse Park in Leicester.

This freed up their old site for retail purposes but also gave Everards chance to build a new up to date brewery and restaurant.

REQUIREMENTS

A sustainable solution for a reinforced carpark using golpla and TTE

Franklin Ellis Architects produced the design which was in two phases.

The first included new buildings with associated parking for Rutland Cycling and Jennos Coffee House who would share the site. Phase 2 was the new Brewery and Beer Hall this also included a new staff car park.

Consultants FPCR were commissioned to produce the landscape designs.

They previously had seminars with Geosynthetics and understood the product range. FPCR suggested grass filled Golpla for the overspill car parking and TTE for the access road, this would help to blend in with the surrounding parkland.
