BACKGROUND

REQUIREMENTS

Supplied Bentotex GCL50 for a reinforced water feature

Landmarc were employed to design and implement the construction of a water feature to compliment the eventually landscaped gardens and house development.

The main reason for the water feature was to use the excavated materials (approximately 6000 tonnes) from the house development to save the cost of moving it off site.



Our Value Engineered SOLUTION

The main reason for using a clay liner was down to the ground conditions of the site. We needed to ensure there was a permanent membrane that would prevent water seepage.

70% of the construction was dammed, with 5m being the highest bund. We like using this material due to the workability of the material and ease of installation.

We have the excavators set up for the installation of the liners, and this works well for us as we can use the same plant and equipment as we already have on site, without having to mobilise different equipment.
